



Fall Semester: August – December (17 weeks) **Spring Semester:** February – June (17 weeks)


Short Term Programs





To study in Mexico, you will require a migratory document that will vary depending on the time you plan to study in Mexico as well as your nationality.

FMM permit

Student profile: students coming to study for a semester or less (180 days or less)

Document required: FMM permit for non-lucrative activities

How to obtain it: You will need to obtain this document in your port of entry to Mexico.

Student Visa

Student Profile: students coming to study for more than a semester or a whole year (181 days or more).

Document need: temporary resident student visa

How to obtain it: You need to obtain this visa at the Mexican Consulate/ Embassy in your home country, and once in Mexico, will need to complete a procedure at the Immigration Office.

Upon your arrival, the International Office will provide you help to make sure you have the proper legal status while studying in Mexico; however, it is very important that, as an international student, you bring a **valid passport** and **proof of financial means to cover your stay.**
