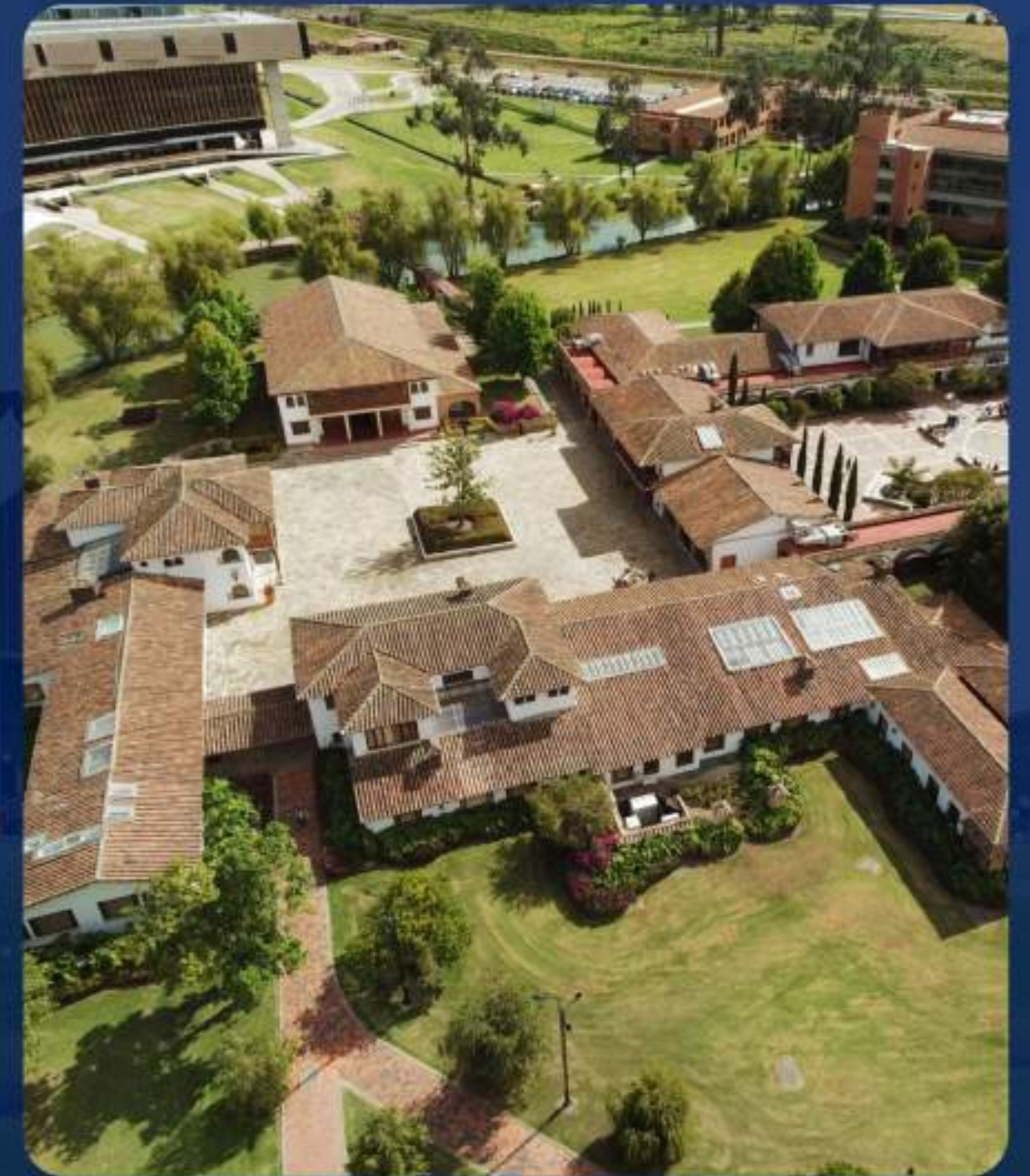

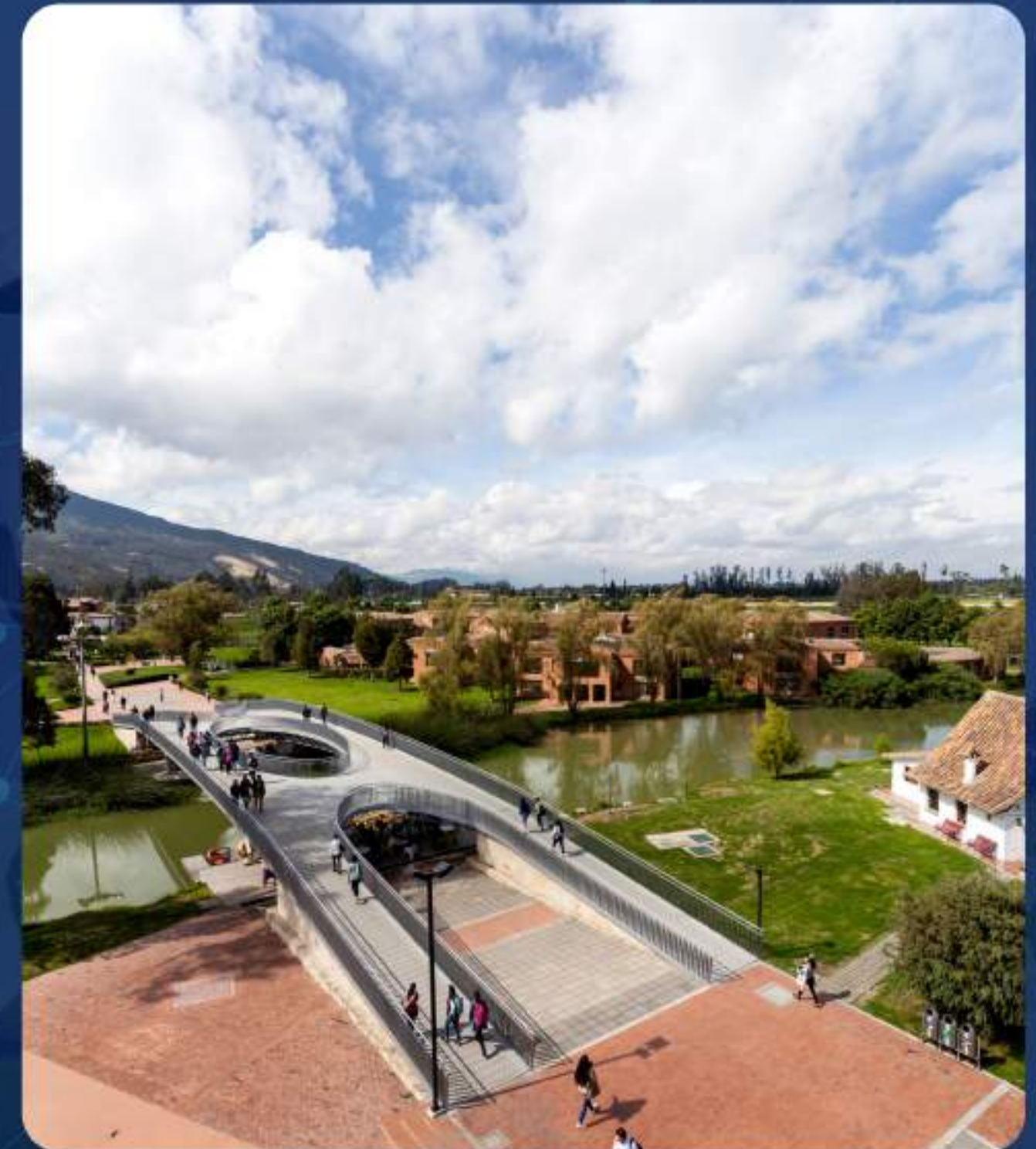

Language Requirements

Students must hold a B2 language certificate (english or spanish) if he/she wants to take classes in a language different than his/her mother tongue. Please note that it is not sufficient to indicate that he/she has an optimal level of english; ***it is necessary to include the level in detail.***

Entry Language Scores:

- TOEFL iBT: 72 (overall)
- IELTS: 5.0 (overall)
- TOEIC: 400 (overall)
- FCE Pass
- Home University Language Department certification with B2 (CEFR)

Living Expenses

 Students can schedule with us their pick-up from International El Dorado Airport until their final destination (Approx. 30 USD)



Average living expenses for the semester:
2.500 USD (4 months):

 **Housing:** From 300 USD up to 800 USD (approx.)

 **Transportation per day:** From 2 USD to 3 USD (approx.), depending on the transportation choice.



 **Meals per day:** from 3 USD to 10 USD per meal (approx.)

Migratory Regulations

1. Before travelling please **verify any visa requirements**. If the student does not need a visa, they will receive a PID letter from us.
2. Upon arrival, the PID letter must be presented to the immigration officer (at the airport).
3. The student will receive a PID stamp that will allow them to stay in the country for 90 days.
4. Before the expiration date, the stamp must be renewed at an immigration office in Bogota.

IMPORTANT: If a visa is not required, but the student plans to stay more than 180 days in Colombia, it is mandatory to apply for a visa
