# How to join?

## Admission requirements:

Applicants should be currently enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's program at one of our partner universities. They should have a good knowledge of English, as the course is taught in English. Prior knowledge of Social Entrepreneurship and/or Intercultural Management is not necessary.

## Costs:

Course fee for...	
two weeks course	700 EUR
three weeks course	1000 EUR

**Costs included:** Accommodation at a student's residence (single room) or hostel/hotel (double room, single room additional costs), course material, welcome package, free wire-less internet access on campus, Münster bus pass for the time of your stay, company visits, social activities.

**Not included:** Travel to and from Germany, visa expenses, health insurance, accident or liability insurance, meals, any additional personal expenses.
