a) Students: enrolled in a BA or MA programme, proof of university enrolment, proof of International or EU Health Insurance, B1 level English, Application form, NO course fee to be paid

b) People without income: proof of unemployment or social aid

b) Non-Students: proof of experience in social-work, dance, cultural work or similar subjects, proof of international health insurance, B1 level English, application form, 150 € course fee

Price:

- Free admission for enrolled students & people without income

- 150 € for non-students

Included costs: private accommodation shared with students of social work, welcome package, action-based learning, creating intercultural choreography, social activities

Not included costs: Travel expenses, visa costs, health insurance, accident or liability insurance, meals or other personal expenses
